Carsington Fishing Report

3rd November 2014



The last week has resulted in an increased rod average to 4.23. The warmer conditions in the later part of the week produced catch returns of 10 or more fish.

It will be interesting to see if this week's colder conditions start to push the fish into deeper water.

Please note - We will be closed for fishing on Wed 5th November 2014.

Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **4.23** with 192 fish caught by 45 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest rainbow caught this week was 4lbs 4oz by Mr Ashworth on a black and red pattern.

The heaviest brown caught was also by Mr Ashworth at 1lb 12oz.

Top Spots

The most successful areas have been North Island, Shiningford Creek, Half moon, Stitch plantation, Upperfields bay, Fishtail creek, Watersports island and the middle of the reservoir.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were minkie, white fritz, black and red, bibio, cruncher, black & green lure, cats whisker, montana and orange blob.

Most fish have been caught using floating and intermediate line on a fast retrieve.

Wednesday 5th November 2014

On Wednesday the 5th November the fishery will be closed all day, we will reopen as normal on Thursday 6th November until Sunday 30th November 2014.
