

Carsington Fishery Report 4th November 2013

The autumn sunshine brought some excellent days fishing in the early part of last week. The weekend was a little more challenging however still producing a weekly rod average of 5.27.

The water temperatures have started to drop with the frosty conditions of the last few days this is likely to push the fish into deeper water so be prepared to try intermediate and sinking lines if there is no action on the surface.

Rod Average

The rod average for last week was **5.27** with 137 fish caught by 26 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest rainbow this week was 4lbs caught by Mr Matthews on an orange blob. A number of browns were caught around 2/3lbs however they were recorded but released due to the closed season for browns.

Top Spots

The most popular spots this week were Fishtail creek, Millfields, Upperfields bay, Stitch Plantation, Sailing Club and watersports island.

Method & Flies

The most popular fly patterns used this week have still been tadpole, gold head montana, black & green lure, Orange gold head blob, white fritz and cats whisker. A variety of lines have been used however most fish have been caught on intermediate lines.

Opening Times

Please note, the fishery will be closed on Thursday 7th November and will reopen on Friday 8th November until Sunday 24th November.

The hours of fishing are now 8.30am – 4pm. This will mean that we only have morning or day tickets available. We do advise that you make a booking in advance as we have had a few disappointed customers this week. Also don't forget to leave us your contact telephone number in case we need to get in touch due to bad weather.

Boats can leave the jetty from 8.30am

All boats are back to the jetty by 4.00pm
