Another great week of fishing with many anglers catching over 20 fish. The reservoir is currently fishing well all over with most anglers choosing to drift or anchor close to shorelines casting into the shallows.

## **Rod Average**

The rod average for this week was 8.85 with 1265 fish caught by 143 anglers.

#### **Best Rainbow/Brown**

The heaviest rainbow this week was 5lbs caught on a montana in Upperfields Bay by Mr G Priest The heaviest brown caught was 3lbs 8oz caught by Paul Jones.

A number of blues have been caught but weights were not recorded.

#### **Top Spots**

The most successful areas have been at the east side including Halfmoon Field, Stitch Plantation, Fishtail Creek, Upperfields bay also Millfields and the Dam wall.

#### **Methods & Flies**

The most successful patterns are gold head montana, cats whisker, hares ear, orange blob, black buzzers and diawl bachs. Most fish have been caught on floating and intermediate lines, close to the shore lines all around the reservoir.

#### **Fly Casting Lessons**

An opportunity to learn the basics of fly fishing, the course covers basic casting, knots and entomology. Our qualified instructor will provide all equipment for the course - you are welcome to bring your own.
