



Carsington Trout fishery

Fishing Report 5th September 2016



As the daylight hours are shortening the fish seem to be more active. Water temperatures are still quite warm near the margins so most fishing has taken place over the main basin and deeper areas like fishtail creek and the dam wall. Two of our regular 'Dappers' Mr Naylor and Mr Houlton had sixteen fish to the boat on Friday using dries, daddies and hoppers.

Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **3.45** with 152 fish caught by 44 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest Rainbow was 3lb 4oz caught by Mr P Pearce.
The heaviest Brown was 3lbs 3oz caught by Mr P Harding.

Top Spot

The most popular spots have been around buoys 4 & 5, Dam wall, Fishtail Creek and middle of water.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were Daddies, hoppers, Boobies, Damsel Nymphs, Black Cormorant, pink snake and Montana. Floating, intermediate and sinking lines have all been used this week.
