The changeable weather this week has made fishing conditions a little more difficult with the rod average dropping a little to 3.11.

We are pleased to announce that we will be staying open this season until Sunday 30th November.

Please Note - We are currently fully booked for Saturday 11th October.

Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **3.11** with 221 fish caught by 71 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest rainbows caught this week were 3lbs 8oz by Mr Nixon & Mr Parry.

The heaviest brown caught was 2lbs 8ozs by Mr Donaldson.

Top Spots

The most successful areas have been Upperfields Bay, Sitch plantation, Fishtail creek, Buoy 4, 5, 7, 8, North end, Brown ale bay and Tower bank.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were minkie, white fritz, orange lure, zulu, daddy long legs, red booby, bibio, black & green lure, cats whisker, montana and orange blob.

Most fish have been caught using floating and intermediate lines.
