Top Spots

The most successful areas have been at Fish Tail creek, Upperfield farm bay, Sitch Plantation, Watersports & Sailing club island.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were black buzzers, daiwl bach, gold head montanna and damsels.

Most fish have been caught on floating and intermediate lines. Many fish have been caught close to the margins on the east side and near Osprey towers.
