

Carsington Fishing Report

7th July 2014

The rod average for this week has increased a little. The water is fishing as we would expect for this time of year. There has been an improvement in fishing at the north end of the reservoir and most fish have been caught in deeper water on the edge of the weed beds.

Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **3.36** with 235 fish caught by 70 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest rainbow this week was 4lbs caught by Mr J Morris on a diawl bach with a floating line near the dam wall. The heaviest brown caught was 3lbs 8oz caught by S Pashley on a damsel nymph near the island.

Top Spots

The most successful areas have been Brown Ale Bay, North end, Dam wall, Fishtail Creek, Upperfields bay and off the back of the islands.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were gold head montana, hares ears, damsel nymph, ace of spades, diawl bachs, orange blob, black fritz, cats whisker, lead bugs, claret popper hopper and black hoppers. Most fish have been caught on floating and intermediate lines. We have seen some decent evening conditions with fish rising to the surface but also fish have been caught in deeper water towards the center of the reservoir on the edge of the weed beds. Some people have been successful on dry patterns.

Early Closing - Sat 12th July 2014

On Sat 12th July the fishery will be closing at 7pm therefore all boats must be back to the jetty just before 7pm.

Fly Casting Lessons
