Drifting between bouys 4,5 and 6 around the mouth of fishtail creek being the best tactic. Several anglers have managed to catch using daddies on floating lines.

Popular areas this week have been drifting across the main basin towards Fishtail creek. Millfields Bay has also proved popular.

### **Methods & Flies**

The most successful patterns were minkie, black or orange blobs, green or black fritz, hot head damsels, cats whisker and dries

There has been a real mix of lines used this week from floating on a drift to sinking with a slow retrieve.
