Top Spots

Once again the most successful areas have been close to the shorelines. The best areas are Halfmoon Field, Stitch Plantation, Fish tail creek, Upperfields and Millfields. These areas have been the most fishable areas due to a week of North Eastly winds.

Method & Flies

The most successful patterns are Black lures, orangel booby, green & black fritz, black tadpole and cormorant. Most fish have been caught in deeper areas on intermediate and sinking lines.
