

# **Carsington Fishing Report**

8<sup>th</sup> September 2014



Excellent fishing conditions this week with most anglers catching fish on a drift across the reservoir. We have received some great feedback on the quality of the water and the fish caught. The NW Nomads and the Carsington Fly Fishers had a very successful day for their competitions on Sunday. Please note, the fishery will close at 6.30pm on Thursday 11th September 2014

## **Rod Average**

The rod average for this week was **6.22** with 554 fish caught by 89 anglers.

### **Best Rainbow/Brown**

The heaviest rainbow caught this week was 5lbs by Mr Hougton on dry flies.

The heaviest brown caught was 1lb 8oz by Mr Neale also on dry flies at the North End.

#### **Top Spots**

The most successful areas have been Millfields, Dam Wall, Sitch plantation, Fishtail creek, Buoy 4, 5, 7, 8 and the middle of the reservoir.

## **Methods & Flies**

The most successful patterns were black & green lures, black gnat, daddy long legs, bibio, cats whisker, montana, hothead damsel, gold ribbed hares ear, black buzzer, black hopper, and diawl bach.

Most fish have been caught whilst drifting across deeper areas of the reservoir using intermediate lines with black & green patterns on a fast retrieve.

Some have had success on floating lines and dries.
