Opening Weekend Report 2015



A great start to the 2015 season, Saturday saw all our out boats for the first day of the season and Saturday's rod average was recorded at 11.2. All anglers braved the cold but dry conditions and caught lots of fish from the eastern side of the reservoir.

Sunday dawned a little chillier but still all anglers had success giving us a collective rod average of 10.76 over the 2 days.

Rod Average

The rod average for this week was **10.76** with 409 fish caught by 38 anglers.

Best Rainbow/Brown

The heaviest rainbow caught this week was 3lbs 12oz by Mr N Cozens.

The heaviest brown caught this week was 3lbs 8oz caught by Mr J Matthews.

Top Spots

The most successful areas have been all along the east side of the reservoir from the Northern end along to Halfmoon bay and Fishtail creek.

Methods & Flies

The most successful patterns were montana, booby, minkie, black and green lures, cats whisker and buzzers.

Most anglers have used sinking lines on a fast retrieve.
